Here is a copy of a recent email from President Steve Anderson to Gyro Club Members:

Subject: FW: Political comments and E-mail Precautions for all Gyro Members

Gentlemen Gyros,

Merry Christmas to all of you, and to all of your family's

The subject of the following message is one of a serious nature and reminds us that this issue is thoughtfully highlighted in part of our Gyro Constitution and By-laws. It sends a clear message of who we are as Gyros and councils us to be reserved and considerate, or to not to participate at all, in exchanging comments pertaining to Politics and Religion.

Recently over the past several months, on two occasions, two Gyro Candidates (guests) have been turned away from their interest in Gyro by negative, polarizing political comments extended by some of our members. One, as recently as last Thursday morning. We should be continually aware that some comments intended to be comical are in fact insulting, negative, and "counterproductive' to our Gyro philosophies. We are joined in friendship regardless of, (in some cases), differing opinion and views of world events. Offhand comments and statements broadcasted without concern for the goodwill of the audience are not appropriate..

The communication below was submitted last year by a Gyro enthusiast who wanted to share a cautioning word, in good faith with us, in a clear understanding of behavior that is not in concert with Gyro ideals.

He stated:

I recently talked with a fellow Gyro that indicated that there was an email, perhaps sent by another Gyro, that was somewhat offensive. Not completely over the top, but something that just struck a wrong chord. I have no idea if this was a video, a cartoon, or a simple email, but it kind of tainted his perception of the Gyro organization. Perhaps, we don't always think about recipients of our emails, and how many times these may be forwarded through group emails. If you think about the diversity within the Gyro organization, you will find many nationalities, religions, cultures, beliefs, and personal values that each of us share.

As an International organization, we have a higher code to which we hold ourselves.

I do not propose to set up guidelines for emails, but I would advise our members to be cognizant of any emails that contain political views, religious slants, cultural innuendoes, or other issues that may compromise the standards that each of hold ourselves as Gyros.

I Just wanted to pass this along as an observation and the possible formation of a best practice.
