#### Message from the Membership Chairman, Steve Anderson

Involvement in Gyro Club Activities is the "Elixir" that Nurtures Strong Clubs:

Good memories though, filled with laughter, and a scrapbook of faces and voices and kindness that always touched me, still remain! My enthusiasm for our Gyro fellowship remains youthful in spirit and even more meaningful with maturity.

What pleases me today, as it always has, are the proposition, and the reality, that the number of friends that add value to life continues to increase as my years of Gyro membership increase. Continuing participation produces smiling new faces, new laughter, new memories, and new friends who are waiting at the end of a Gyro handshake extended in greeting.

I am, I suppose, naïve in my amazement that some of our Gyro brothers loose the sense of personal fulfillment and satisfaction when someone calls them friend.
