### U.S. - Canadían Border Friendship Plagues

Recently speaking with Richard Leister about his trip to Niagara Falls refreshed my memory of a Gyro bit of information that you may find interesting.

Bronze plaques, recognizing Gyro International, are permanently mounted on two U.S. / Canadian border crossings. One is midway on the Rainbow Bridge in Niagara Falls, and the other in Washington State at the Blaine Peace Arch crossing.

The plaques are there to recognize and pay tribute to Gyro Int'l for the friendship it fosters between the two countries, and for "the Hands of Friendship across the Border" demonstrated by the frequent gatherings between club members from each country. It has been customary every few years for Gyro members, and families in Border Clubs, to also meet for a picnic, and a ceremonial plaque cleaning.

Because of the friendship among the clubs of both countries, Gyro International has been recognized by several U.S. Presidents and Canadian Prime Ministers. Those letters of appreciation were, (I believe) published in the 2012 Centennial issue of the GyroScope commemorating 100 years of Gyro Friendship.
